Annual districted clean-up days are available.
- **COMMERCIAL FRANCHISE AGREEMENT**  
Green Waste offers 1 to 6 cubic yard bins, collected 1 to 6 times a week. The same size bins are also available for recyclables.
- **DEBRIS BOX INFORMATION**  
Green-Waste offers debris boxes ranging from 10 to 40 cubic yards. Debris boxes are great for construction sites, property clean-ups, remodeling debris, yard and garage clean-ups. Availability on box sizes varies. Please call Green-Waste at (408) 283-4819 for fees and more information.
- **HOLIDAY TREE REMOVAL**  
Call GreenWaste Recovery at (408) 283-4800 for information. Green Waste will pick up both flocked and un-flocked trees. Cut into five foot lengths and dispose on your regular pick up day.

Aseptic Containers	X		Milk cartons and juice boxes accepted; place in blue bin.
Large Item Pick-Up	X		\$21.00 for each item. One free item per year.
Cans	X		Aluminum, tin, bi-metal and steel cans; rinse and place in blue bin.
Cardboard	X		Corrugated cardboard and cereal boxes; bundled flat 2'x2'x2'.
Glass	X		Bottles and jars; rinse and place in recycling bin; labels OK.
Household Batteries	X		Place in clear plastic bag, and on your recycling cart.
Newspaper	X		Place in recycling cart.
Magazines	X		Place in recycling cart.
Mixed Paper	X		Place in recycling cart
Metals, Other	X		Pie tins, aluminum foil, etc. Place in recycling cart.
Metals, Scrap	X		Place in blue bin 2'x2'x2' bundle. Less than 40 lbs.
Oil	X		Place in one gallon container with secure top; limit four per household per collection (obtain containers from GreenWaste Recovery).
Oil Filters	X		Obtain containers from GreenWaste Recovery.
Plastic (#1-#7)	X		Remove caps, flatten; place in recycling cart.
Polystyrene (Plastic #6)	X		Place in recycling cart.
Yard Trimmings	X		Residents are provided a green 95-gallon wheeled card for yard trimmings collection. Yard trimmings collection is weekly with the recycling and garbage collection.
