Aseptic Containers	X		Milk and Juice Cartons accepted. Place on Plastics Metal, and Glass side of bin.
Large Item Pick-Up	X		\$34.26 for each item.
Metal Cans, Scraps	X		Aluminum, tin and bi-metal cans and small metal items can be placed in the Plastics, Metal, and Glass side of recycling bin. Large metal items can be brought to the Recycling Drop-Off Center.
Cardboard	X		Corrugated cardboard only; flatten, bundle no larger than 4' x 4'; set next to recycling bins.
Glass	X		Glass bottles and jars; lids are O.K.; rinse and place in bin.
Household Batteries	X		Curbside collection for single family homes, drop off for all faculty staff residents. http://bgm.stanford.edu/pssi_residential_universal_waste .
